

# How far is your home from your workplace?




## How far is your home from your workplace?









  - Hybrids – 3,3 %


# Transport mode used daily in summer compared to winter


# Transport mode used after the Corona pandemic compared to winter 2019

  - Average: **7 days** per month










# The bicycle connection to my workplace is:


